A lifelong Utahn, Maggie attended the University of Utah as a Communication major with an emphasis in Journalism. During her time at the U, she worked as an opinion writer for The Daily Utah Chronicle, a position that, according to her staff bio, let her "clear the cynicism from her system, allowing her to enjoy the beauty of Utah."

Much of Maggie's work was communityoriented and focused on people and populations often overlooked or muted by the media, and although we knew her as a student, Maggie was also a compassionate and loving daughter, sister and friend to many.

It was that compassion and empathy that made Maggie a cherished member of the University of Utah and of the larger Salt Lake community. "Maggie was just someone that had a heart of gold, who was always concerned about other people," her father, Jason, said.

Maggie passed away in August 2022 while preparing to begin her senior year.
